

- 2020 22: Cassol Centerlar Head of Planning and Innovation Cassol Centerlar invited me to deliver their Marketplace platform. It was a big challenge for the available time four months. After the success of marketplace launched, I was invited to establish a Portfolio Organization and deliver a project management methodology for new projects. In the first year, I managed + \$60 MM in investments with a breakeven average of 3 to 5 years, in addition to having facilitated the delivery of + \$15 MM between cost reduction and additional revenue generation in the three main sales channels digital, direct sales and stores.
